Dr. Schulman has lectured extensively on behavioral optometry topics such as vision in the classroom, vision and aging, visual difficulties in the developmentally delayed, and lectured and published on vision and autism. She specializes in behavioral optometry and vision therapy, pediatrics, learning disabilities and preventative, integrative and alternative vision care for all ages.



Power Tools: Lens and Prism Seminar

The Power Tools seminar on lenses and prisms is a must attend for practitioners wishing to gain a better understanding of how to use lenses and prisms in an optometric practice in diagnosing, prescribing, and therapeutic use. Attendees will learn about the behavioral model of vision, the giants in the field, and how to utilize lenses and prisms in order to make improvements in function for patients.

You will learn about how changes in visual input affect the brain and body in all areas including: balance and coordination, posture, movement, speech and language, cognition, processing, behavior, attention, and arousal and emotions. Optical, refractive and various visual conditions such as strabismus, amblyopia, and accommodative and binocular dysfunctions will be considered and specific guidelines for prescribing plus and minus lenses as well as base in and base out prisms will be discussed such as compensatory, stress-relieving, developmental, and therapeutic ways of prescribing. You will also learn about yoked prisms and how to use them both in prescribing and in therapy in the following ways: compensatory, therapeutic, disruptive and constructive. Best practices will be discussed based on age, development, demands, aging, computer use and special populations including for developmentally delayed, concussion, acquired brain injured, field loss/neglect, elderly and sports vision patients. You will learn about cases and therapeutic activities as well as get a chance to experience the power of lenses and prisms directly in the hands-on workshop part of the course.

This course is suitable for both new practitioners as well as established practitioners looking for a fresh look at these awesome tools. Vision therapists will also gain a working knowledge of the use of lenses and prisms in the therapy room.
