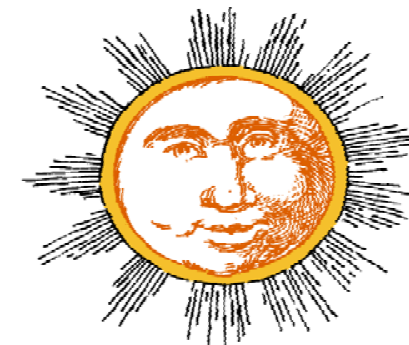

Using Sensory, Motor and Reflex Integration Techniques to Enhance Vision Therapy Outcomes

Course Description

In day-to-day practice we have all seen the positive life changing effects that good vision therapy has on individuals with oculomotor dysfunction and visual perceptual problems. Further developing our understanding of how the brain makes neurological connections will help you to understand why our vision therapy techniques are so powerful. This workshop will feature reflex integration, sensory integration and motor control theories that vision therapy practices can use to wire the brain for improved function.

During this two day, twelve-hour course, we will explore the development of the nervous system. We will also highlight sensory integration and motor development theories that can be paired with our vision therapy models of practice. Hands on assessment techniques, live demonstrations, and video analysis will be used to train participants on medically accepted methods used to assess atypical patterns of movement, evidence of retained primitive reflexes, and delays in the development of postural reflexes. Participants will also learn to how to incorporate reflex integration exercises and sensory integration techniques to build the neurological foundations of oculomotor and visual perceptual skills.

Dr. Alex Andrich is a graduate of The Ohio State University College of Optometry and is in private practice in North Royalton, Ohio. Dr. Andrich is currently serving as the president of the International Sports Vision Association. Additionally, Dr. Andrich is a vision coach to the Cleveland Monsters hockey team and Cleveland Gladiators arena football team. He is professionally involved at state, national and international levels. When he is not busy with optometry, Dr. Andrich enjoys spending time with his family, playing tennis, and mountain biking.

PATTI ANDRICH, MA, OTR/L, COVT, INPP/L is an occupational therapist known for her success in treating individuals with difficulties in visual-motor, visual-perceptual, auditory perception and vestibular functioning. Patti received her Master degree from The Ohio State University College of Education and her occupational therapy degree from the Cleveland State University Department of Health Sciences. Additionally, Patti holds certifications in auditory processing using The Listening Program and Integrated Listening Systems with Bone Conduction. Patti received certification in primitive reflex integration techniques; having studied in the UK under the direction of Sally Goddard at the Institute of Neurological Physiological Psychology (INPP).

Patti is a certified vision therapist, member of The Optometric Extension Program as well as the College of Optometrists in Vision Development, the recipient of several honors and awards and has been a guest speaker for local, state, national and international conferences.
