Vision's Interaction with Other Senses:

Many speak about the five senses as if they were all created equal. This includes members of the eye care professions. This kind of view has led some fields to attempt to own "reading" problems or "reversals," for example, because they could be seen as auditory or kinesthetic problems. The visual process is used by humans to derive meaning and direct action. In many behavioral models, it incorporates input from and integration with all the other sensory modalities. Course Description/Highlights

CCVC is a unique meeting that draws attendees from all over the world. Students and Residents are welcome to attend on a space available basis, adding to the diversity of the group.
