David Cook, O.D. and his strabismus seminars are known to audiences in Canada, New Zealand, and across the United States. He has limited his practice to vision therapy for over 35 years and is a pioneer in using 3D movies in strabismus treatment. He is an OEP associate, a fellow in COVD, and a diplomate in binocular vision and perception in the American Academy of Optometry. He served on the COVD

International Exam Board for six years. His *Visual Fitness*, published by Berkeley Books, appeared in English, Polish and Russian. His article "Eyesight, Infinity, and the Human Heart," won the optometric editor's award. His *When Your Child Struggles* has helped thousands of patients to receive care in vision therapy practices across the United States.



The Exotropia Seminar

(Including a review of Esotropia and Amblyopia)

Surprisingly, exotropia can present some of the most difficult challenges in vision therapy. The treatment of exotropia includes both aligning eyes and making sure the patient performs comfortably and efficiently when the eyes are aligned. Alignment does not ensure comfort, and comfort does not ensure alignment. Procedures for both are needed. How does therapy vary when the exotropia is constant versus intermittent? Day one will cover the basics of exotropia treatment including convergence insufficiency, divergence excess, and constant exotropia. Attendees will finish the day with a understanding of exotropia and a wealth of tools for treating it.

Day two will review clinical pearls for the treatment of Refractive and Strabismic Amblyopia as well as Constant and Intermittent Esotropia, including working around strabismic adaptations such as Eccentric Fixation and Anomalous Retinal Correspondence. Demonstrations of clinical pearls will be provided to help understand moving from the world of esotropia to the world of binocular vision.

Along with information on preschool strabismus, overcorrecting prism, and the Vivid Vision virtual reality system, both days stress the basics underlying the development of stereopsis for performance in life--for exotropic, esotropic, and non-strabismic patients alike.

Learn from Dr. Cook's forty years of experience working with strabismus, including many new insights since his last OEP Regional Clinical Seminar series.

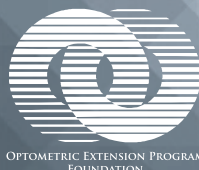
