Curtis Baxstrom, MA, OD, FCOVD, FAAO, FANO



Dr. Baxstrom received is O.D. degree from Pacific University and a MA degree in Reading from Seattle Pacific University. He opened a vision therapy/ vision rehabilitation practice in Federal Way, Washington in 1992. In addition, he consults at two local rehabilitation hospitals providing Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation services.

He is also an adjunct professor at Pacific University, and is the Director of Vision Northwest Vision Therapy/Rehabilitation Residency sponsored by Pacific University. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Optometry, the College of Optometrists in Vision Development and the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association.

Dr. Baxstrom is actively involved in COVID and NORA. In 2018 he received the G.N. Getman Award from COVID. He currently serves as the Immediate Past President of the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association. He has also received the Advancement of Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Award and the William and Diane Ludlam Educator's Award. In his community he is involved in his Lion's club and has received the Melvin Jones Fellow Award. When not involved in Optometry he is a climbing instructor and leader for the Mountaineers. He has published multiple articles and lectured at meetings across the globe.

Earl Smith III, OD, PhD, FAAO

Earl Smith received his Doctor of Optometry and PhD from the University of Houston in 1972 and 1978 respectively, and joined the faculty at the University of Houston College of Optometry in 1978. He is the past Dean of the University of Houston College of Optometry and was selected as the Greeman-Petty Distinguished Professor in Vision Development in 1988. His primary research interests are centered on the effects of normal and abnormal visual experience on the developing visual system.

Janice Wensveen, OD, PhD

Janice Wensveen, OD, PhD received her Doctor of Optometry degree from the University of Waterloo School of Optometry and her PhD for the University of Houston College of Optometry. She is currently a Clinical Associate Professor at UCHO where she teaches clinical binocular vision. Her research centers on abnormal development of binocular vision, anisometropia, strabismus, and amblyopia
